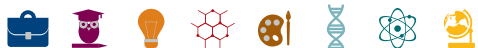

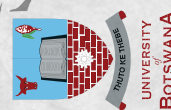




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APPLICATION GUIDELINES



Kindly read the information below before you complete an application online

1. One applicant should submit only one application.
2. For one to apply online, s/he should have an active **e-mail account**.
3. Prospective applicants should read the entry requirements carefully and ensure that they apply for programmes for which they meet the general and specific requirements including the Application Cut Off points. Meeting the minimum entry requirements does not guarantee admission **as admission is based on academic merit and availability of space**.
4. A list of undergraduate programmes offered by the University of Botswana and the 2022 Guide on Application Cut-off points are part of the Application Package. **All the listed undergraduate programmes are registered with the Botswana Qualifications Authority (BQA)**. Applicants are therefore advised to select programmes carefully taking into account the strength of their grades and the 2022 Guide on Application Cut-off points. The 2022 Guide on Application Cut-Off Points are a **Guide only** and should therefore not be treated as the **Final Admission Cut-Off Points**.
5. In completing the application, prospective applicants should enter their study choices in order of preference, and then select the programme offer mode such as Full-time, Part-time or Distance Learning, plus the Campus where each of the two programmes is offered.
6. Prospective applicants are required to pay an **APPLICATION FEE, WHICH IS NON REFUNDABLE**, online through the link <https://www.ub.bw/ubpayments> or into the University of Botswana (UB) bank accounts listed under Schedule of Fees and Financial Procedures, which is part of the Application Package. Prospective applicants may also pay the **Application Fee** at any UB Cash Offices at Main Campus in Gaborone; Centre for Continuing Education (CCE) in Francistown or Okavango Research Institute (ORI) in Maun. Prospective applicants may **ONLY PAY** the Application Fee if they meet all the set requirements as the **APPLICATION FEE IS NON REFUNDABLE**.
7. The receipt for the **Application Fee** payment should be scanned in readiness for uploading into the application. A copy of the payment receipt should be kept safely by the applicant.
8. For programmes of study that require work experience, a reference statement from the applicant's supervisor confirming the nature and length of the work experience should be scanned in readiness for uploading into the application. The applicant must have the required experience by the date of submission of the application.

9. **Normal Entry:** Normal Entry means that an applicant is in possession of the requirements as stated in the intended programme of study, e.g. School Certificate, Certificate/Degree/ Diploma Certificate, and/or the required work experience in some cases.
10. **Mature Age Entry (MAE):** This is a special route reserved only for Botswana nationals who do not possess the normal entry qualifications. Applicants under this category are required to take appropriate MAE Examination. Undergraduate study programmes with this special entry route have this listed under their specific requirements.
11. Applicants, who applied for programmes with an interview or test as part of the selection process, are advised to enquire about the schedules for such if they do not receive any notification **one month after the closing date.**
12. Applicants will be notified of the dates of the selection interview(s) or test(s) they are required to attend and those who for whatever reason fail to attend a scheduled oral or written interview, will automatically be dropped from the selection list for that particular programme.
13. Applicants are also encouraged to always keep safe the information they receive during the application period and also through the acknowledgement notification they will receive from Undergraduate Admissions office.
14. **Applicants with Disability:** The University of Botswana welcomes applicants with disability and considers their applications on academic merit like all other applicants. All applicants are expected to state whether they have any disability or not when they apply, so that the **University's Disability Support Services Unit** can contact them to appreciate the nature of their disability. The declaration of such information helps the University in assessing the learning needs of all applicants. Prospective applicants with disability may contact **University's Disability Support Services Unit at: (+267) 355-2768/4990/4991/4183.** University of Botswana will at all times preserve the confidentiality of student information.
15. Prospective applicants are expected to scan and save separately, **preferably in pdf format**, all the required documents in readiness for uploading during application:
- receipt for a fully paid Application Fee
 - certified copy of the Omang for citizens ONLY or the Passport for other nationalities
 - certified copy of the School certificate **(or a certified copy of the Statement of Results for those still awaiting the issuance of their certificates)**, accompanied (if not in English) by a certified official English translation version.
 - certified copies of additional official documents e.g. post-school certificate(s), transcript(s), professional registration certificate(s), certifying letters from Examining bodies, proof of change of name, etc where applicable.



NB: Citizens under the age of 16 or those who have applied for Omang as they have just reached the age of 16 should provide certified copies of their Birth Certificate

16. The onus is on all applicants to ensure that they upload all required documents with their application. Any application that does not have all the required documents will not be processed.
17. **How to complete an Application Online:** University of Botswana (UB) has an online application system that is intended to accord anyone seeking admission into UB study programmes to apply online provided they have an **active email account**. Prospective applicants are therefore expected to make their applications online through the **"STUDY"** link on the University of Botswana Website: www.ub.bw. Prospective applicants may use any Internet facility available to them to apply anytime of the day during the application period.
18. A guide, in the form of a booklet, on how to complete an application online, titled **"ONLINE APPLICATION: A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE"**, is provided through the **"STUDY"** link.
19. Once you have submitted your application, an acknowledgement notification will be sent to you by email.
20. **Selection Procedure:** The Undergraduate Admissions office will review and process applications immediately after the closing date and applicants who are required to attend selection interviews or tests will be notified accordingly.
21. Applicants must ensure that they provide correct **email address** and **mobile number** as these will be used to communicate any matter regarding their applications.
22. **Change of Name/Surname:** Applicants are to provide proof of change of name(s) if their Certificate(s) and/or other official documents show different names. **THE UNIVERSITY ONLY ACCEPTS AN AFFIDAVIT FROM THE MINISTRY OF NATIONALITY, IMMIGRATION & GENDER AFFAIRS.**
23. Applicants are encouraged to always request for the name of the UB staff attending them either telephonically or otherwise.

GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- a. The general minimum ENTRY requirements to the University shall be the Botswana General Certificate of Secondary Education (BGCSE) / equivalent qualification with at least six subjects NOT below a grade of E.
- b. For all programmes, English Language shall be one of the qualifying subjects.
- c. English Language must at least be a minimum of grade C for non-science degree programmes and at least a minimum of grade D for science-based programmes.
- d. For Degree programmes, at least five subjects shall be at a minimum of grade C obtained at one or two examination sittings.
- e. For Diploma and Certificate programmes, at least a minimum of three grades of C with a minimum of grade E in English Language shall be required. Five subjects may be considered if the minimum cut-off point based on six subjects is met.
- f. The minimum entry BGCSE points shall be 34 points for all undergraduate Degree and 30 points for Diploma and Certificate programmes.
- g. The stipulated length of relevant work experience where required must have been met at the time of submitting the application.
- h. Any additional and/or special ENTRY requirements shall be specified under the programme offerings.
- i. Applicants shall be considered only for the study programmes they have selected.
- j. When applying for a programme which is offered by both full-time and distance learning mode, indicate whether the application is for full-time or distance learning, otherwise if not indicated it will be assumed the application is for a full-time programme.
- k. Meeting the minimum entry requirements does not guarantee admission. Admission will depend on availability of space and the competitive strength of each applicant's grades.
- l. Applicants may make changes to their programme choices. Such changes should be communicated in writing to the undergraduate admissions office.
- m. Applicants with BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum of grade E in English Language may be considered for admission into Bachelors Degree programmes.

All the programmes of study listed below are registered with the Botswana Qualifications Authority (BQA)

Note:

University of Botswana has observed that the Admission Cut Off Points for different study programmes average around both the Overall and Programme Points listed. The said averages are displayed as the Application Cut Off Points, which **serve as a guide to prospective applicants as they select their study choices**. Both the Overall and Programme Points listed are the minimum points that each prospective applicant has to satisfy in order to apply for their study choices.

Some programmes show **Overall Points ONLY**; while others show both the **Overall and Programme Points**. Admission into programmes with the Overall Points only is based on **OVERALL POINTS ONLY**, while admission into programmes with both the **Overall and Programme Points** is based on **PROGRAMME POINTS**, although they also have to meet the Overall Points.

Prospective applicants should note that these Application cut-off points are just a Guide, NOT THE FINAL ADMISSION CUT OFF POINTS, hence meeting them does not guarantee admission.

CAREERS IN FINANCE

The Bachelor of Finance Program aims at providing quality graduates with skills in financial management. International finance, international monetary system, investment management, credit management, banking practice, marketing of financial services, credit risk management, actual analysis, corporate risk management, tax planning and insurance.

CAREERS IN BUSINESS INFORMATION SYSTEMS

The Bachelor of Information Systems (Business Information systems) program will equip students with skills of function as systems analysts, and programmers, system integrators, network administrators, database administrator, web-developers, systems security officers, and end-user specialists, computer auditors, projects managers and telecommunications specialists. The program is applied rather than theoretical. Although it is based on fundamental principles, its focus will be

determined by concerns of the industry and will be adjusted as this change.

CAREERS IN BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MARKETING)

The versatility of marketing makes persons with marketing skills in demand in any organization that can only achieve their objectives through getting other to act in a desired way. Thus, marketing skills are needed in any organization that has a target audience whose needs have to be identified or anticipated and satisfied through the conception, production and delivery of goods and services, e.g. in business, government, social, parastatal, financial, professional, religious, political, or educational organization or institutions.

Those interested in becoming professional or chartered marketers can take the qualifying examination of marketing professional associations such as the Institute of Marketing (UK), Marketing Federation of Southern Africa (RSA) and the American Marketing.

CAREER PROSPECTS IN BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MANAGEMENT)

Graduates of this programme can be employed in numerous professional positions available in different sectors of the economy such as project managers, management consultants, self employed

entrepreneurs, operational managers and operational strategists, logistics and inventory managers, administrative officers, human resources managers, training and development officers, corporate management experts, organization and management analysts, planners and development management experts and system analysts

CAREER PROSPECTS IN BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (TOURISM & HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT)

This program will definitely widen the students employment opportunities and upgrade management skills in the following areas;

1. Hotels: Hotel/camp manager; food and beverage manager; front office manager; executive housekeeper; executive chef.

Bachelor of Education (Art and Design)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:
BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum grade of C in English Language.

Applicants with Diploma in Primary/Secondary Education with a specialisation in art or its equivalent enter at Level 300.

Applicants with a Diploma in Visual Arts from recognised institutions enter at Level 300.

Applicants with a Diploma in Primary/Secondary Education with a non-art specialisation or its equivalent enter at Level 200.

Applicants with a Certificate in Visual Arts from recognised institutions enter at Level 200.

Applicants with a Teaching Certificate or its equivalent enter at Level 100.

Bachelor of Education (Business)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:
BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum of grade C in English Language and Mathematics.

Applicants possessing an appropriate Diploma may enter at level 200 or 300 depending on the quality and number of credits obtained.

Bachelor of Education (Counselling)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:
BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum of grade C in English Language.

Holders of a Certificate in Education or its equivalent plus BGCSE with at least three grades at a minimum of grade C shall enter at Level 100.

Relevant work experience in counselling, or guidance and counselling shall be an added advantage.

Holders of a Certificate in Education or its equivalent who do not meet the requirements above but who have experience in counselling, or guidance and counselling shall be admitted into Level 100 of the programme. Applicants seeking admission through this route shall submit recommendation letters and proof of experience in counselling, or guidance and counselling.

Applicants with a Diploma or its equivalent in Adult Education, Home Economics, Nursing, Physical Health and Recreation, Primary Education or Secondary Education, Social Work or Theology, or any other relevant field shall be admitted into either Level 200 or Level 300 on the basis of accumulated credits in the area of Counsellor

Education. Relevant work experience shall be an added advantage.

Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood Development & Education)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:
BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum of grade C in English Language.

Applicants with a relevant Certificate shall enter at Level 100. Relevant work experience in an educational or child related setting shall be an added advantage.

Applicants with a relevant Diploma shall be admitted into Level 200 or 300 of the Degree Programme on the basis of accumulated credits in the area of education or child related setting. Relevant work experience in an educational or child related setting shall be an added advantage.

Bachelor of Education (Family and Consumer Sciences)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:
BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum of Grade C in English

Language, Biology and/or Chemistry or related science combinations.

A minimum of grade C in any Family and Consumer Sciences or Home Economics subject shall be an added advantage.

Applicants with a Diploma in Family and Consumer Sciences or Home Economics or a Diploma in Secondary Education from Colleges of Education or its equivalent shall be admitted into Level 200 or 300 of the Degree Programme on the basis of accumulated credits in the area of Family and Consumer Sciences or Home Economics.

Bachelor of Educational Leadership and Management

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:
Applicants with a Diploma in Educational Leadership and Management or equivalent shall enter at Level 300 of the degree programme.

Applicants with a Diploma in Education or its equivalent shall be admitted into either Level 200 or 300 of the Degree Programme on the basis of accumulated credits in the area of Educational Leadership and Management or related areas. Relevant work experience in an educational setting shall be an added advantage.

Holders of a Teaching

Certificate plus BGCSE will normally enter at level 100. Reference will be made to the articulation policy of the University of Botswana to determine the possibility of entering at other levels as appropriate.

Holders of a Teaching Certificate or its equivalent who do not meet the requirements above but have experience in an educational setting as managers will be admitted into level 100. Applicants seeking admission through this route shall submit recommendation letters and proof of experience in teaching and evidence of prior learning.

Bachelor of Education (Lifelong Learning and Community Development)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:
BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum of grade C in English Language. Preference shall be given to applicants with some work experience in adult education, extension-work and community development.

Applicants possessing a Diploma in Adult Education or related field will be considered for entry at Level 300. Preference shall be given to applicants with some work experience in adult education, extension-work and community development.

Bachelor of Education (Science)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:
BGCSE with a minimum of grade D in English Language and a grade of C in Mathematics, and grades of C in any two from Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or a minimum of grade BB in Science Double Award or equivalent, or a minimum of grade A in Physical Science and a grade C in Biology, or equivalent.

Bachelor of Education (Secondary)

Duration (Years): 3 years

Specific Entry Requirements:
Applicants with a Diploma in Secondary Education or its equivalent shall be admitted into either Level 200 or 300 of the Degree Programme based on accumulated credits in the area of specialization. Teaching experience shall be an added advantage.

Bachelor of Education (Special Education)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:

BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum grade of D in English Language and grade C in Mathematics and one Science subject, or a minimum of grade BB in Science Double Award for those wishing to specialize in Science; a minimum grade of C in English Language for those wishing to specialize in Humanities.

Applicants who have a Diploma in Education or its equivalent, e.g. in Physical Education, Home Economics, Social work, Special Education, shall be admitted into either Level 200 or Level 300 based on accumulated credits in the area of Special Education. Teaching experience in Special Education shall be an added advantage.

Applicants who have a Certificate in Special Education or its equivalent plus BGCSE with at least three grades at a minimum of grade C shall be admitted into Level 100.

Bachelor of Music Education

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:

BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum grade of C in English Language and have studied music.

Applicants with a 3 year Diploma in Primary/Secondary Education with a specialisation in music education or its equivalent shall normally enter at Level 300.

Applicants with a 2-year Diploma in Primary Education or its equivalent shall normally enter at Level 200.

Applicants with a Certificate in Primary Education or its equivalent shall enter at Level 100.

Bachelor of Primary Education

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:

BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum grade of C in English Language. Applicants who want to specialise in Mathematics and/Science Education must have a minimum grade D in English language, and a grade C in Mathematics and/Science or Science Double Award.

Applicants with a 3-year Diploma in Primary Education or its equivalent shall normally enter at Level 300.

Holders of a 2-year Diploma in Primary Education or equivalent

shall normally enter at Level 200.

Holders of Certificate in Primary Education or its equivalent shall enter at Level 100.

Diploma in Lifelong Learning and Community Development

Duration (Years): 2 years

Specific Entry Requirements:

BGCSE/equivalent. Preference shall be given to applicants with some work experience in adult education, extension-work and community development.

Applicants who do not meet the above requirements but have BGCSE and evidence of relevant prior learning and experience in adult education, extension work and community development may be considered. Applicants seeking admission through this route may be called for assessment.

Applicants possessing a Certificate in Adult Education or in a related field may be admitted to Level 200.

management, forester, environmental planner, limnology, landscape engineering, ecological modeling, environmental audit, natural resources management, wildlife research, environmental journalism, environmental law, biodiversity conservation, ecological impact assessment

FOOD AND BEVERAGES:

Brewing industries, quality control, food technologists, microbiologist, product development, food marketing, and nutrition.

CHEMISTRY:

Academic, Analytical laboratories such as at National Environmental Lab, Food Research Centre, the Veterinary Lab, Water Affairs, Forensic Lab, and Mineral processing entities such as BCL, Tati Nickel etc

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE:

Environmental Science students graduate into science-based professions of various government departments, district authorities, non-governmental organisations and the private sector. In short, Environmental Science is a multidisciplinary area of study, which enables graduates to develop careers in a wide range of sectors of the national, regional, and global economies. Much of the Environmental Science curricular is relevant to UN conventions such as biological diversity (UNCBD), desertification (UNCCD), climate change (UNFCCC) and sustainable development

(UNCSD). As such, the graduates not only find relevance locally, but also internationally.

Computing academics, computer programmer/analyst, applications programmer, software engineer, hardware engineer, computing network administrator, database administrator, systems consultant, marketing representative, information systems manager etc

GEOLOGY:

Prospective employers include Departments of Geological surveys, Water Affairs Roads etc other employers include mining, mineral and groundwater exploration companies, environmental institutions etc.

PHYSICS :

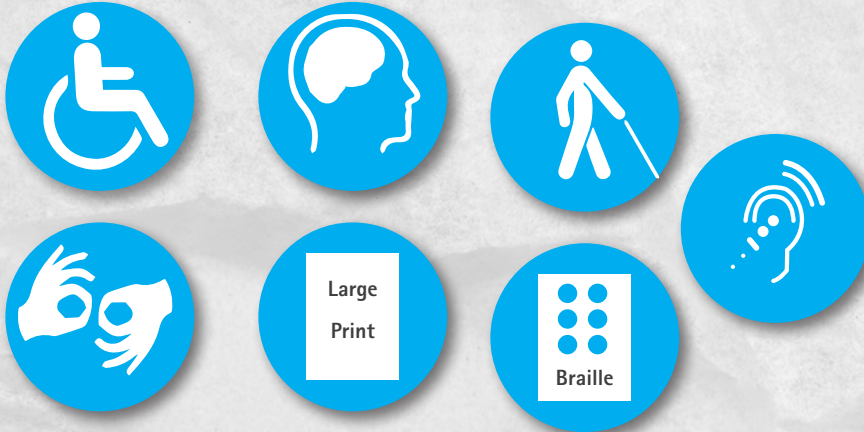

- a. A copy of the deposit slip or prove of online payment (with your name & ID written on) should be attached to Application Forms when these are submitted or sent to **Undergraduate Admissions Office** of the University of Botswana, Academic Services department. Applicants who pay fees in this manner need not queue at University Cashier's Office for payment before submitting application forms. This method of payment also avoids acquisition of post office Postal Orders for onward transmission to the University as a form of payment.
- b. International students residing in Botswana should bring with them copies of employment contract and residence/work permit for their parent(s). For self-employed, bring tax

certificate, company certificate and residence/work permit. Such students should also present passports for appropriate identification by country of origin.

3. Payment Plan for self-sponsored students

Self-sponsored students are allowed to pay tuition fees in four installments as follows:

- **1st instalment** of at least 25% of the tuition and related fees, paid before registration.
- **2nd instalment** of at least 25% of the tuition fee, by the end of the first month following month of registration.
- **3rd instalment** of at least 25% of the tuition fee, by the end of the second month following the month of registration.
- **4th instalment** of at least 25% of the tuition fee, by the end of the third month following the month of registration
